We were very pleased with an unannounced Ofsted inspection on 26th May. The quality and standard of the early years provision is 'good'.

Summary of key findings; Staff regularly observe and assess children's play so they can identify challenging next steps. Consequently, staff have a secure knowledge of how to promote children's learning and development and prepare them for school.

Staff provide all children with ample opportunities to explore natural resources. This engages children and motivates them to learn.

Staff skillfully support children who are learning Eng-

lish as an additional language and work in partnership with their parents to complement their child's learning of the family's home language.

Staff have effective relationships with other settings that children attend and schools they move onto to, providing a consistent approach to children's learning and aid a smooth move to school.

The management is committed to driving improvement.

Staff have excellent relationships with parents. They learn about children's routine at home to support their emotional needs.

Recommendations to

further improve practice;

Occasionally, staff need to give children time to answer questions so they can develop their thinking skills. Consider group sizes during adult led activities so all children can participate. The inspector observed registration time and felt the children would benefit if they were in smaller groups.

22nd June from 3.00-4.15p.m. Invites will be sent home shortly.

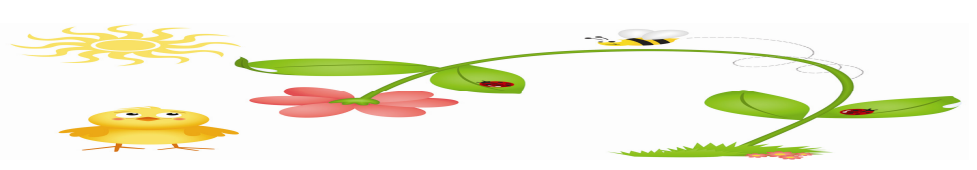
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The Barnardos toddle
